restraints of trade that the Shreem Act was designed to combate, e.g.Nat'l Soc'y of Prof'l Eng'rs v. United States 35 U.S. 679 (1978) (condemning iets restriction on competitive bidding). For a professional association to pribe honest competition as "unethical" behavior is particularly problematic because, as the Court has recognized, association members can be "expected to comply in order to as the they [do] not discredit themselves by
