OPPOSITION TO AHP'S MOTION TO QUASH TWO SUBPEONAS AD  
TESTIFICANDUM SERVED ON AHP AFTER AHP'S WITHDRAWAL FROM  
ADJUDICATION AND, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**
