


JURISDICTION AND VENUE



In connection with the offering of franchises, as "franchise" is defined in Section 436.2(a) of the Franchise Rule, defendants Universal and Robert Ruffeino violate Section 436.1(a) of the Rule and Section 5(a) of the FTC Act by failing to provide prospective franchisees with complete and accurate basic disclosure documents as prescribed by the Rule.
