

ORDER ON APPLICATION FOR ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENAS

On October 23, 2002, Complaint Counsel, pursuant to Rule 3.34(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, filed an application for the issuance of 24 subpoenas commanding persons to attend and give testimony at the adjudicative hearing in this matter. According to Complaint Counsel's final witness list, which provides a brief description of the intended testimony of each individual, the testimony sought appears to be reasonably relevant. Complaint Counsel has not represented whether the individuals are located in the United States.

The application is GRANTED, with the limitation that subpoenas for individuals located outside the United States will not be issued unless the requirements of Rule 3.36 are met. This Order does not constitute a ruling on the admissibility of testimony from the witnesses. Complaint Counsel shall prepare the subpoenas for my signature and arrange an appropriate time to pick up the signed subpoenas.
