**THIRD UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO QUASH SUBPOENA**

Samsung Semiconductor Inc. ("Samsung"), a non-party to the above-captioned case, through undersigned counsel, files this third motion for an extension of time for Samsung to file a motion to quash the Federal Trade Commission's ("FTC") Subpoena Duces Tecum ("Subpoena").

The FTC served Samsung with the Subpoena on October 14, 2002. Under the applicable procedures, Samsung has moved for and received extensions of time to file a motion to quash the Subpoena. Samsung's most recent motion for extension of time was filed on October 31, 2002 wherein Samsung sought an extension of time to further negotiate with opposing counsel concerning the scope of the Subpoena. The present deadline for Samsung to file a motion to quash the Subpoena is November 15, 2002.

Counsel are negotiating an agreement to resolve Samsung's complaints about the scope and burden of the Subpoena and other issues regarding the Subpoena. To date, Samsung has produced approximately 55,000 pages of documents to the parties in response to their subpoenas. In addition, Samsung has prepared and produced summary




