Thank you for your comments on behalf of Citizens for Voluntary Trade ("CVT") regarding the proposed consent order accepted by the Federal Trade Commission for public comment in the above-captioned matter. Your letter indicates that CVT opposes the proposed settlement because it believes that the First Amendment does not permit the Commission to restrict KFCC's future advertising merely because its past advertising was deceptive, and that the Commission's action does not achieve a benefit that would not otherwise be achieved through the free market.

After considering your comments, the Commission has determined that the public interest would best be served by issuing the Decision and Order in final form without modification.
