

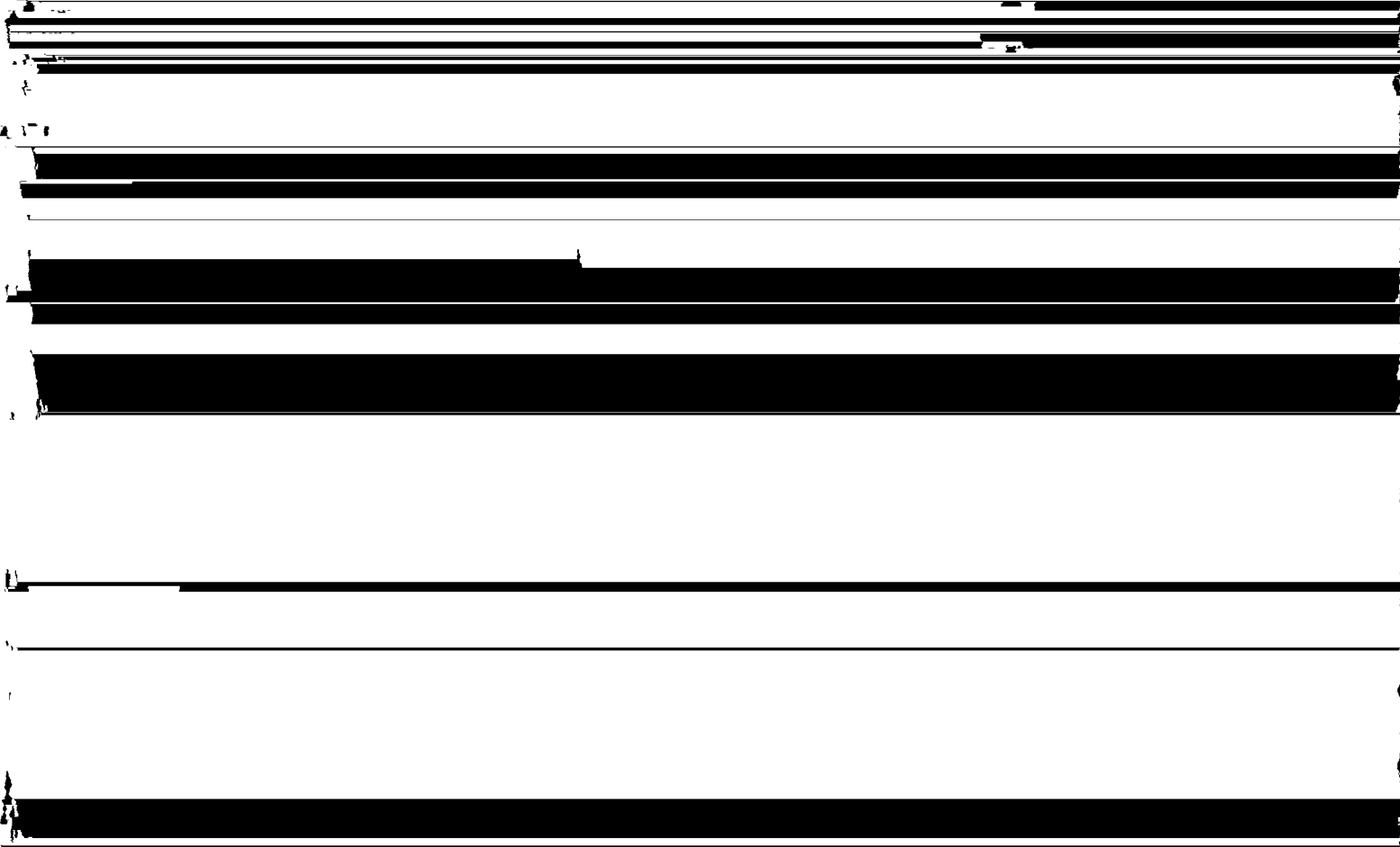

**CONTEMPT ORDER**

Plaintiff, Federal Trade Commission (“FTC” or “Commission”) filed on November 10,

**ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES as follows:**

**FINDINGS**

The Commission has shown the following facts by clear and convincing evidence:

1. As of the date the Preliminary Injunction was entered, defendants owned or controlled the following five real properties in Welland, Ontario, Canada: 30 Jackson Court

West, 185 Denistoun Street Unit 54, 185 Denistoun Street Unit 107, 91-93 East Main Street, and

not limited to, the following real properties located in Welland, Ontario, Canada: 30 Jackson Court West, 185 Denistoun Street Unit 54, 185 Denistoun Street Unit 107, 91-93 East Main Street, and 78 Jackson Court West;

2. To the extent that any of the above real properties or any other real property

subject to the Preliminary Injunction is transferred or sold, the entire proceeds of any such sale or transfer shall be deposited immediately into the Registry of the United States District Court for

the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division;

3. Defendants, jointly and severally, are hereby fined a total of \$5,000.00 per day beginning on the day this Contempt Order is entered and continuing thereafter until all defendants bring themselves into compliance with Section II of the Preliminary Injunction and all

with Section II of the Preliminary Injunction and with the terms of this Contempt Order
