H. EO Supply Agreement—Increased Flexibility and Control for Ineos

Several amendments provide Ineos with increased flexibility and control over its purchases and payments under the EO Supply Agreement.

Ineos' right to access other supply options during times of diminished EO supply from Dow has been expanded in order to respond to Ineos' goal of increasing the practicality of the swap option under the Agreement. An expanded set of circumstances under which Ineos can seek other EO supply options, a significantly reduced (from seven days to two days) notice period for Ineos to alert Dow that it is pursuing such an option, and a timeframe for the other supply option that runs through the *expected* (if later than actual) duration of reduced supply will


