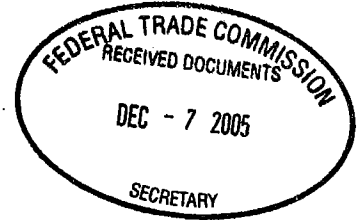

**I.**

On November 23, 2005, Respondents filed three motions: Motion to Exclude Complaint Counsel Witness Heymsfield or in the Alternative to Limit His Testimony; Motion to Exclude
