6 A. Judgment is entered against defendants Thomas L. Delanoy and

13 Commission no later than five (5) days after the date of entry of this Order.

17 account administered by the Commission or its agent to be used for equitable relief,
18 including but not limited to consumer redress, and any attendant expenses for the
19 administration of such equitable relief. In the event that direct redress to

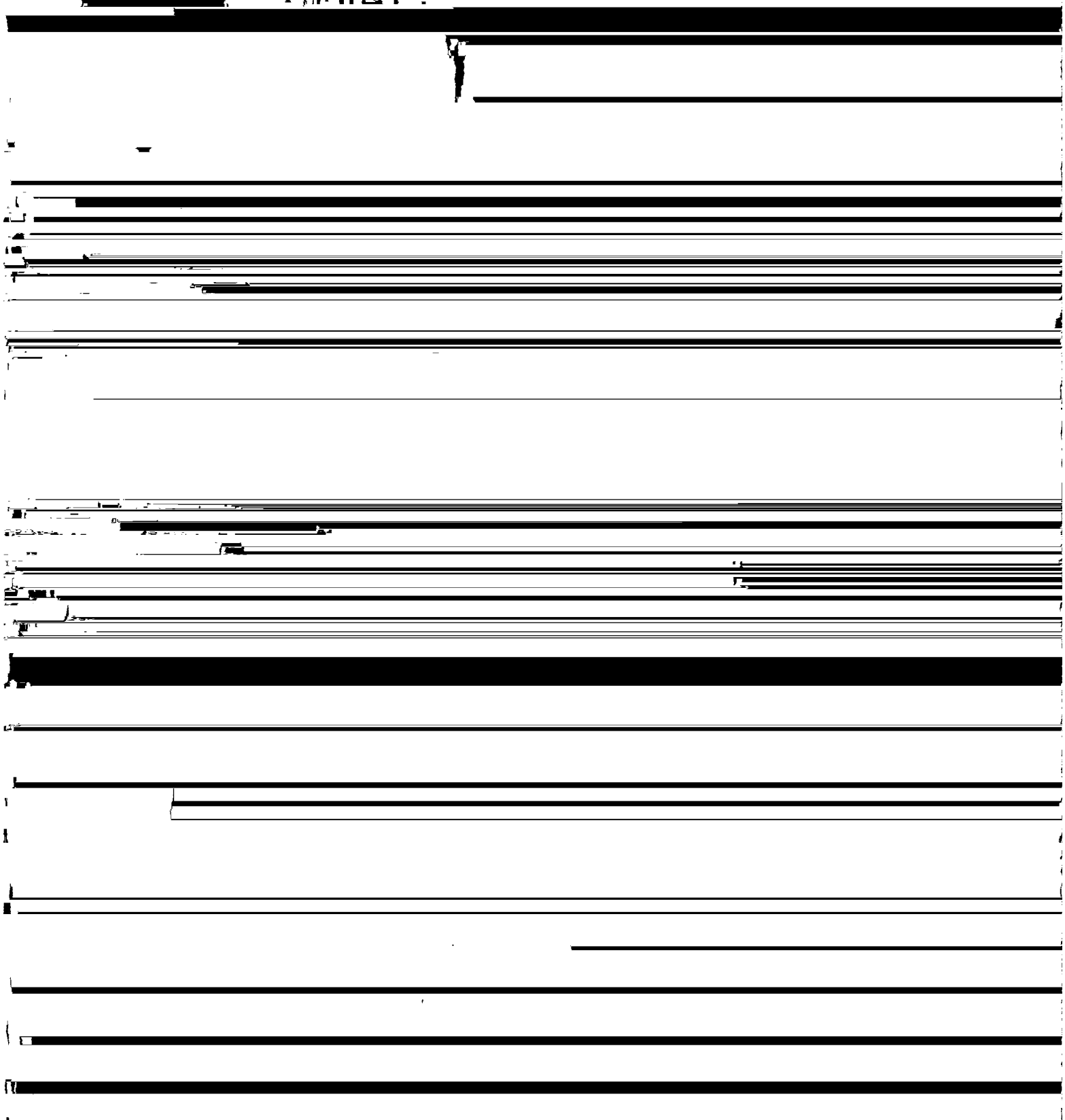
