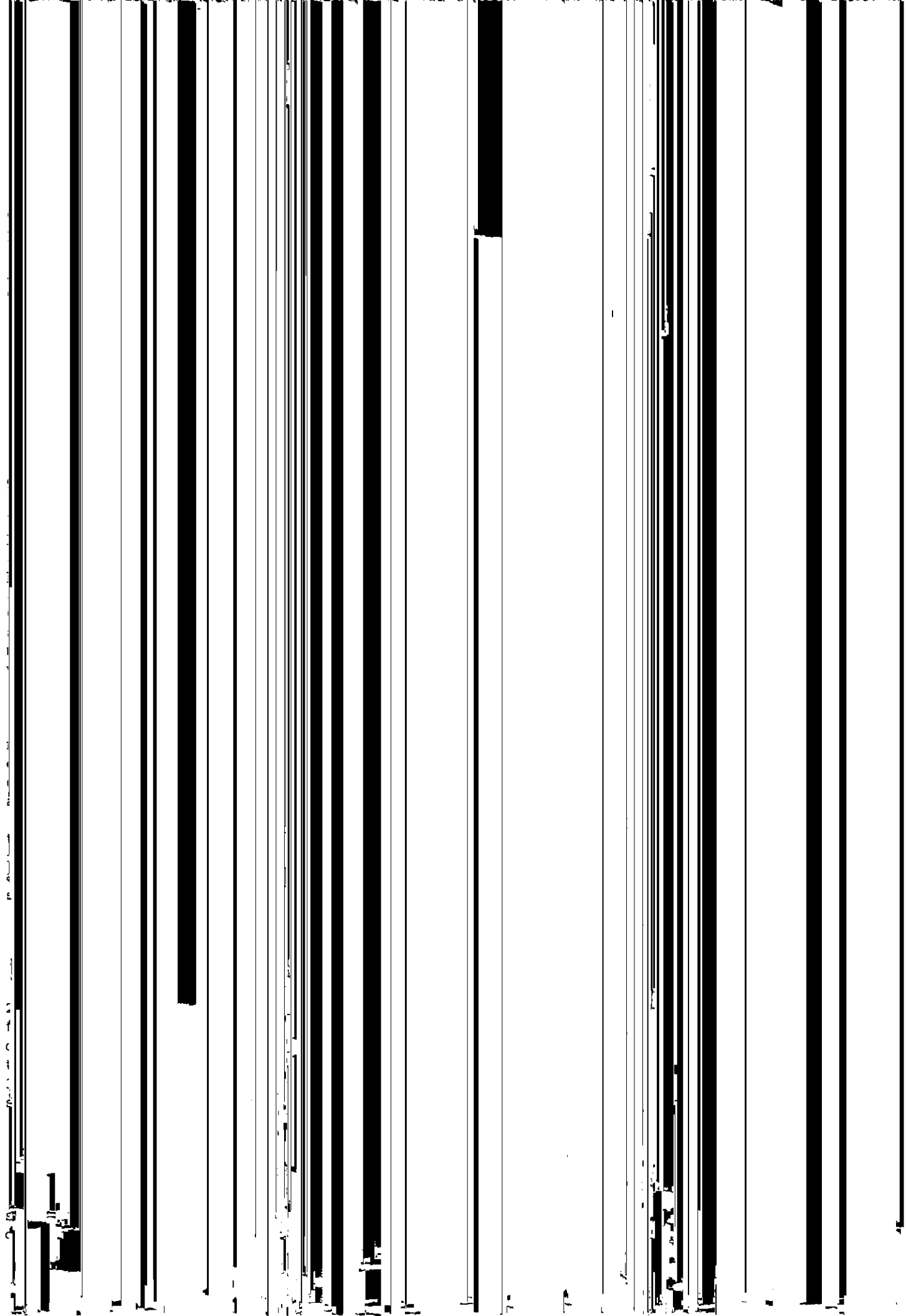

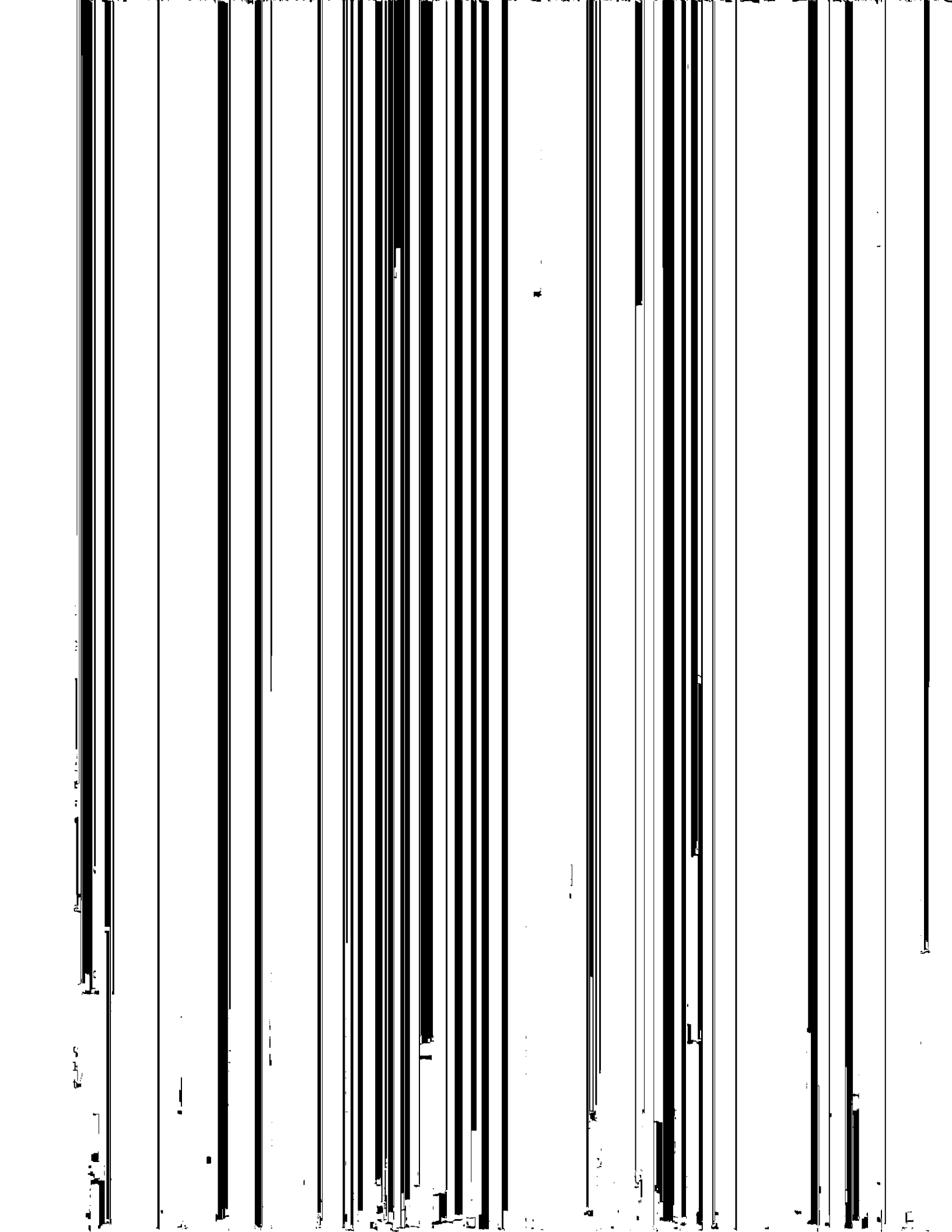

Sec. 70f. Injunction proceedings

Whenever the Commission  
(a) that any person  
section 70a, 70c, 70d, 70e, or 70f  
be unlawful; and

(b) that it would be

The Federal Trade Commission Act, 1914, ch. 311, 38 Stat. 719, is amended to read, in part, as follows: "Sec. 70f. Injunction proceedings. (a) Whenever the Commission finds that any person is engaged in any act prohibited by section 70a, 70c, 70d, 70e, or 70f of this title, or that such act is about to be committed, the Commission may bring suit in any United States court in any Territory in which such person is engaged in the doing of such act and upon the granting of a restraining order shall be granted. (b) Whenever the Commission finds that it would be in the public interest to enjoin the doing of such act until compliance with the Commission's order is achieved, or until an order of the Commission has become final under the Commission Act, the Commission may bring suit in any United States court in any Territory in which such person is engaged in the doing of such act and upon the granting of a restraining order shall be granted.
