- A. all advetisements, promotional materials, and a ther statemets containing any representations covered by this order, with all materials relied upon in disseminating the presentation; and
- B. any documents, whether prepa

report, in writing, setting forth in detail the manner and form in which it has complied with this order.

This order will terminate twenty (20) years from the date of its issuance, dowenty (20) years from the most recent date that the United States or the Commission files a complaint (with or without an accompanying consent dence) in federal court alleging any violation of the order
