COMPLAINT

The Federal Trade Commission ("Commission"), having eason to believe that Respondent, Fidiley National Financial, hc. ("Fidelity"), a corporation subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission, has purchased three title insurance underwriters — Commonwealth and Title hsurance Company ("Commonwealth"), Lawyers Title hsurance Corporation (Lawyers"), and United Capital Title hsurance Company ("United") — from LandAmeirca Financial Goup, hc. ("LandAm"), a coporation subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission, in violation of Section 7 of the Claryn Act, as an ended, 15 U.S.C. § 18, and Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 45, and it appearing the DEFINITIONS

1. "Title Plant" means a privately owned ollection of records and/or indices regarding the ownesship of and interests in real proprey. The term includes such colletons that are regularly maintained and updated by obtaining information or documents from the public

- 3. "Acquisition" means the aquisition by Fidelity of Commonwealth, awyers, and United (collectively, the "LFG Underwriters") from LandAm pursuant to an amendestock purchase agreement dated Novneber 25, 2008.
- 4. "Respondent" or "Fidelity" means Fidelity National Financial, Inc., its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns, and its subsidiaries, divisions, pint ventures, goups and failiates in each case controlled by Fidelity (including but not limited to, the EG Underwriters, Searity Title Guaranty Co., and Ticor Titlersurane Company), and the respective directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns of each.

II. RESPONDENT

- 5. Respondent is a quotration organized, exiting and doing business under nad by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, with its executive offices located ta601 Riverside Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. Respondent, among other things, is engaged in the sale of title insurance and the provision of title information services.
 - 6. Respondent is a paper subject to the jurisdiction of the Commissi
- 7. Respondent is, and alt taim es relevant herein has ben, engaged in commerce, as "commerce" is defined in Section 1 of the Clayton Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C.§ 12, and is a corporation whose business is in, ofeats, commerceas "commerce is defined in Section 4 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, as annealed, 15 U.S.C.§ 44.

III. THE ACQUIRED SUBSIDIARIES

8. Commonwealth and Lawyers were title insurance underwriters with their executive offices located at 5600 Cox Road, Glen Allen, VA 23060, while United was atitle insurance underwriter with its executive office located at 3250 Wilshire Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90010. Commonwealth, Lawyers, and United were engaged, among other things, in the sale of title insurance and the provision of title information services.

IV. THE ACQUISITION

9. On Novembe 25, 2008, Respondent da Land Am enteed into an Acquisition Agreement under which Fide ity acquied three of Land Am's title insurance underwriters for an amount valued, take time of entering into the Acquisition Agreement, at approximately \$258 milli on ("Acquisition").

V. THE RELEVANT MARKETS

10. For the purposes of this Complaint, the relevant line of commerce in which to analyze the effects of the Acquisition is the provision of title information services.

IX. VIOLATIONS CHARGED

- 15. The allegations contained in pagraphs 114 are repeated and realleged as though fully set forth hee.
- 16. The Acquisition Agreement descibed in Paragaph 9 onstitutes a violation of Section 5 of the FC Act, as mended, 15 U.S.C. § 45.
- 17. The Acquisition described in Paragaph 9 constituted a violation of Setion 7 of the Clayton Act, as mended, 15 U.S.C. § 18, and Seerc 5 of the FTC At; as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 45.

WHEREFORE, THE PREMIS	SES CONSIDERED, the Federal Trade Commission on this, 2010, issues its Complaint against said Respondent.
