The Commission apprecies your support of theoresent agement. Specificly, you state that the Commission suld make the poposed or definal because it addresse important privacy issues. The Commission is committed to safguarding consumer pivacy and believe that the proposed over requires Google Inc. ("Google") to build and maintain strong pacy protections for all its products and secres. As you noted, the consteorder madates that Google establish and maintain comprehensive privacy program that addresse privacy risks related to new ad existing products and secres and that protets the privacy and confidentiality of "covered information."

Under the orde, Google is prohibited from misrepsenting the privacy and confidentiality of any covered information, as well as the company's adherence to any privacy, secuity, or other ompliance pogram. The companyalso must give Gogle users notice and obtain express affinative conset prior to sharing their identified information with anythird party in connection with a change to any product or service, where such sharing is contrary to stated sharing practices in effect at the time of collection.

To the extent permissible under lative public mayhave access to the submissions required pursuant to the ordeln some cases, these docenents may contain trade secrets or other confidential commercial or financial information, or information about on summers or other third parties, that would be exempt from public disclosure. Acordingly, as provided by statute, companies may request confidential treatment for these documents or portions of these documents undecommission proceduars. Upon recipt of sub a request, the Commission conducts areview to determine whethe confidential treatment is waranted.
