## ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On Novembe 17, 2011, the Edeal Trade Commission issued the Administrative Complaint in this matter, having as on to believe that Responds OSF Helphcare System ("OSF") and Rockford Health System ("RHS") had executed an affiliation agreement which, if consummated, would violate Sieon 7 of the Claton Act, as mended, 15 U.S.C. § 18. Complaint Coursel and Respondents have now filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss Complaint, which states that the Repondents are bandoning the proposed faliation, and have withdrawn the Hat-Scott-Rodino Notification and Report First they filed for the proposed tansation.

The Commission has determined to dismines Administrative Complaint without prejudice as the most important elements of Makef set out in the Notice of Contemplate Relief in the Administrative Complaint have complished without the need of further administrative litigation. In particular, Respondents have mounced that they are abandoning

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission has determined that the public interest warrants dismissal of the Administrative Complainthinstmatter. The Commission has determined to do so without prejudice, hower, because is not reaching a decision on the merits. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Administrative Complaint in the matter be, need it hereby is, dismissed without prejudice
