Commission's final order and liable for civil monetary penalties of up to \$16,000 per violation, pursuant to Section 5(l) of the FTC Act.

In terms of redress for alleged prior misconduct regarding RxAmerica's mail order program, the order requires CVSC to pay \$5 million in consumer redress, to be distributed to eligible RxAmerica Medicare Part D beneficiaries who purchased at least one generic drug at a CVS or Walgreens pharmacy in 2007 and/or 2008. To the extent that you believe you or your husband were injured by conduct not covered by the proposed order, you are free to contact the FTC's Consumer Response Center at (877) 282-4357, file a complaint online at [www.ftccomplaintassistant.gov](http://www.ftccomplaintassistant.gov). The complaint will then be entered into our Consumer Sentinel database and made available to FTC investigators and hundreds of other law enforcement agencies.
