ARGUMENT

Because the Phone Records contains is experienced information under Rule 3.45(b), this Court should grain cameratreatment for all Phone ecords for a period of ten years. Rule 3.45(b) of the Federal Ter Commission's Rules Fractice explicitly allows for in camera reatment of evidence that "constitutes sensitive personal information." 16 C.F.R. § 3.45(b). Series personal information under Rule 3.45(b) includes numbers and records dintifiable by individual." Id. On September 14, 2012, this Court "determined that phone records pecially those that are subpoenaed, constitute sensitive personal information and records of the FTC Rules." McWane Tr. at 2233 (Sept. 14, 2012).

Under Rule 3.45(b)'s definition, and this Court's September 14, 2012 finding, the Phone Records constitute sensitives sonal information eligible foin camera treatment.
