documents responsive to the subpo**end**, the district court denied the Commission's petition for enforcement, **pa**rt, on the grounds that the work product doctrine shielded **e**hdocuments from disclosur **&** ee Memorandum Opinion (docket #69), issued September 27, 2012.

The Commission intends to present flokeowing issues in this appeal:

1. Whether the district court improperly sustained Boehringer's claim to work product protection for financial **aby**ses concerning a joint marketing (or "co-promotion") agreement due to its rebatiship to an agreement to settle patent litigation, despite Boehringer's persister services that the co-promotion agreement was free-standing and **prefe**dent of the litigation settlement.

2. Whether the district court e

agreement or the patent litigation settlement) did not contain or reflect the legal opinions or judgments of counsel.

4. Whether the Commission met its **bein** of showing the necessity for the information in the documents to caoryt its law enforcement investigation and the unavailability of such information by you other means, so as to overcome any work product protection that mightave attached to the documents.

5. Whether the district court, **and** dressing the Commission's need for the information in the documents and opining that such information would not significantly add to the Commission's knlewdge about issues relevant to the investigation, improperly blocked legit**ante** avenues of the Commission's inquiry in a manner that transgressed the establisheits of a court asked to enforce an investigative subpoena.
