COMPLAINT

Pursuant to the provisions of the Federal Trade Commission Act and the Clayton Act, and byvirtue of the athority vested bysaid Acts, the Edeal Trade Commission (the "Commission"), having reason to blieve that repondent Oltrin Solutions, LLC ("Oltrin," a joint venture between TriOlin LLC, a subsidiary of Olin Corporation, and Trinity Manufacturing, Inc.) entered into a transaction (the "Transaction") with JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. ("JCI"), in violation of Section 7 of the Clayin Act, as anended, 15 U.S.C. § 18, and Searc 5 of the Federal TradeCommission Act, as anneeled, 15 U.S.C. § 45, and it apping to the Commission that a pr Manufacturing, Inc. and TriOlin LLC, asubsidiary of Olin Corporation, and was formed in 2007. Oltrin purcheses and esells all of the sodium pochlorite ('bleach'') produced for external salestathe Trinity-operated plant in Hanlet, North Carolina.

II. RESPONDENT JCI JONES CHEMICALS, INC.

2. Responden CJ is a privatelyheld, family-owned companyheadquatered at 1765 Ringling Blvd., Saraota, Florida 34236. CI is one of the word's leading manufacturers and distributors of waterreatment chemic as and it produces base hand other bemicals naionwide at eleven manufacturing plants. Prior to entering into a non-competition agreement with Respondent Otrin in connection the Transaction, JCI was engaged in the manufacture and sale of bleach from its plant in Charlotte, North Calina.

III. RESPONDENT OLI N CORPORATION

3. Respondent Olin Corporation Q(fn") is a publicly-traded corporation incorporated in Virginia and headquarteed at 190 Carondelet Plaza, Suite 1530, Cobay Missouri, 63105. Olin produces arisesty of chemicals and is the lagest North American produce of bleach. Respondent Oltrin is a joint ventumetween TriOlin LLC, a subsidiary of Olin, and Trinity Manufacturing, Inc.

IV. RESPONDENT TRINITY MANUF ACTURING, INC.

4. Trinity Manufacturing, Inc. ("Trinity") is a privately-owned markeer of bleach and otherchemicas, headquatered at 11 E.V. Hogn Dr., Hamlet, North Carolina, 28345. Trinity operates a bleach plant in Hamlet, North Carolina. All of the bleach produced at the Hamlet plant is sold to Trinity and that portion intende of fexternal sales resold through Oltrin, which is a joint venture between Trinity and TriOlin LLC.

V. JURISDICTION

5. Respondents Oltrin, JCI, Olin, and Trinity are, and at all times relevant herein have ben, engaged in commerce as "commerce" is defined in Section 1 of th@layton Act, as amendel, 15 U.S.C. § 12, and accerporations whose businessers in or affect commerce as "commerce" is defined in Section 4 of the deral TradeCommission Act, as anneeled, 15 U.S.C. § 44.

VI. THE TRANSACTION

6. h March 2010, Oltrin ageed to payJCI \$5.5 million over bur years for, among other things, a list of the bulk bleak customers to JCs Charlotte, Noth Carolina plant, and ha agreement that JCI would not sell bulk bleach in North Carolina or South Carolina for six years.
