- 6. Proposed respondent has read the draft complaint and consent order. It understands that it may be liable for civil penalties in the amount provided by law and other appropriate relief for each violation of the order after it becomes final
- 7. Proposed respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations in the draft complaint, except as specifically stated in this order. Only for the purposes of this action, proposed respondent admits the facts negative to establish jurisdiction

## **DEFINITIONS**

For purposes of this order, the following definitions shall apply:

- 1. Unless otherwise specified, "respondent" shall mean TBWA Worldwinde, a corporation, its successors and assigns and its officers, agents, representatives, and employees, but shall not include any corporation, subsidiary, or division that does not peder the name TBWA/Chiat/Day, Chiat/Day, or any substantially similar name.
- 2. "Commerce" shall mean as defined in Section 4 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 44.
