This is in reference to the Petition For Approval of Proposed Divestiture filed by Service Corporation International (“SCI”) and received on April 30, 2014, and the Petition For Approval of Proposed Divestiture filed by SCI and received on June 10, 2014 (collectively the “Petitions”).
