As such, the Commission has jurisdiction only to fashion remedies that are required to fix the contribute concerns that arise from violations of federal antitrust law. Accordingly, the Consent Order is designed to address the competitive issues raised by the Acquisition. The Sweetbay store on Ehrlich Road in Tampa, Flowing closed by Delhaize pror to the Acquisition; therefore, its not one of the Delhaize stores (Bi) will acquire. Consequently, the former Sweetbay store was not part of the Commission's review of the Acquisition. Moreover, teclosure of a store is not, by itself, a violation of federal antitrust law even though a store closure can be a significant loss to the local community it serves.
