in which event it will take such action as it may consider appropriate, or issue and servete

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent, within sixty (60) days after the date of service of this order, shall file with the Commissiona true and accurate report, in writing, setting forth in detail the manner and form of its compliance with this order. Within ten (10) days of receipt of written notice from a representative of the Commission, it shall submit an additional true and accurate written report.

VI.

This order will terminate twenty (20) years from the date of its issuance, or twenty (20) years from themost recent date that the United States or the Commission illes a complaint (with or without an accompanying consent decree) in federal court alleging any violation of the order, whichever comes later; provided, however, that the filling of such a complaint will not affect the duration of:

- A. any Part in this order that terminates in fewer than twenty (20) years;
- B. this order's application to any respondent that is not named as a defendant in such complaint; and
- C. this order if such complaint is filed after the order has terminated pursuant to this Part.
