

Analysis of Proposed Consent Order to Aid Public Comment  
In the Matter of Nice-Pak Products, Inc., File No. 132272

The Federal Trade Commission (“FTC” or “Commission”) has accepted, subject to final approval, an agreement containing consent order from Nice-Pak Products, Inc. (“Nice-Pak”).

The proposed consent order has been placed on the public record for thirty (30) days for receipt of comments by interested persons. Comments received during this period will become part of the public record. After thirty (30) days, the Commission will again review the agreement and the comments received, and will decide whether it should withdraw from the agreement and take appropriate action or make final the agreement’s proposed order.

Nice-Pak is a manufacturer of “flushable” moist toilet tissue made from non elemental chlorine bleached wood pulp, bicomponent fibers and EP907 repulpable binder. It advertised the flushable moist toilet tissue as being safe for sewer and septic systems.

Part IV of the proposed order contains recordkeeping requirements for
