All reports shall be verified by a notarized signature or sworn statement by a responsible person at the Proposed Respondent specifically authorized to perform this function, or self-verified in the manner set forth in 28 U.S.C. §1746. Section 2.41(a) of the Commission Rules C.F.R. § 2.41, requires that an original and

11. Proposed Respondent has read the proposed Complaint and the Decision and Order contemplated hereby. Proposed Respondent understands that once the Decision and Order has been issued, it will be required to file one or more compliance reports showing how it has complied and is complying with the Decision and Order. Proposed Respondent further understands that it may be liable for civil penalties in the amount provided by law for each violation of the Decision and Order after it becomes final.
12. By signing this Consent Agreement, the Proposed Respondent represents and warrants that it can accomplish the full relief contemplated by the attached Decision and Order. Proposed Respondent agrees to comply with the draft Decision and Order from the date it signs this Consent Agreement.
