ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO OPPOSE TO WEBEYECARE'S MOTION TO QUASH

Non-party WebEyeCare filed a Motion to Quash Complainant Counsel's Subpoena on October 14, 2016 ("Motion to Quash"). Opposition to the Motion to Quash was due October 24, 2016. In the instant motion, on October 24, 2016, Complainant Counsel seeks an extension of time to October 31, 2016, stating that the parties are in negotiations of a settlement and that an extension of time to Quash and have jointly concluded that additional time for negotiations may yield a resolution of all the issues.
