COMPLAINT

Pursuant to the provisions of the Federal Trade Commission Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 41, et seq., and by virtue of the authority vested in it by said Act,

appearing to the Commission that a proceeding in the public interest, hereby issues this Complaint stating

NATURE

1. Oregon Lithoprint, Inc. ("OLI") publishes a newspaper distributed principally in Yamhill County, Oregon. OLI has invited Yamhill County to divide geographical advertising territory, inviting collusion, OLI endangered competition.

RESULTS

2. OLI is a corporation organized, existing and operating under the laws of Oregon with its principal place of business in Yamhill County, Oregon.
3. OLI publishes a twice weekly community newspaper of the NewsRegister, as well as community newspapers.
4. The NewsRegister has a circulation of approximately 10,000 copies in Yamhill County, Oregon. In addition to its purchase in newsstands in Yamhill County, Oregon, the NewsRegister is also available to subscribers.

JURISDICTION

5. At all times relevant herein, QLI has been, and is now, a corporation as a "corporation" is defined in Section 4 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 44.
6. The business practices of QLI

As we continue our efforts, I would invite Pamplin Media Group to join NewsRegister Publishing Co. in a formal request to parties placing foreclosure notices – including private attorney firms – that the notices be placed using the “best suited” language concept as we understand the intent of that legal phrase.

14. On August 31, 2016, through counsel, Pamplin Media repudiated the invitation and stated its disagreement with Mr. Bladine’s interpretation of Oregon law related to the placement of foreclosure notices.
