DECISION

The Federal Trade Commission ("Commission") initiated an investigation of certain acts and practices of Your Therapy Source, Neeraj Jindal, and Sheri Yarbray, collectively "Responderst" The Commission's Bureau of Competition prepared and finished of Responders the Draft Complaint which it proposed to present to the Commission for its consideration issued by the Commission, the Draft Complaint would charg Responders twith violations of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 45.

Respondenstand the Bureau of Competition executed an agreement ("Agreement Containing Consent Ordeor "Consent Agreemen) Containing (1) an admission by Respondents of all the jurisdictional factsets forth in the DraftComplaint (2) a statement that the signing said agreement is for settlement purposes only and does not an admission by Respondent that the law has been violated as alleged in Draft Complaint, or that the facts as alleged in the Draft Oplaint, other than jurisdictional facts, are true(3) waivers and other provisions as required by the Commission's, Rules and (4) a proposed Decision and Order.

The Commission considered the matter and determined that it had reason to believe that Respondentiave violated the said Act, and that a complaint should issue stating its charges in that respective Commissionaccepted the Consent Agreement and placed it on the public record for a period of 30 days for the receipt and consideration of

public comments The Commission duly considered any comments received from interested persons pursuant to Commission Rule 2.34, 16 C.F.R. § 2.34. Now, in further conformity with the procedure desibed in Rule 2.34, the Commission issues its Complaint, makes the following jurisdictional findingend issues the following Decision and Order ("Order"):

For a period of 3years from the date this Order is issued vide a copy of this Order and the Complaint to any person who becomesfiaer, partner, director, oremployee of Your Therapy Sourceandprovide such copies within 30 days of the commencement of such Person's employment or term as an officer, partner, directoror employee and
- C. Retain documents and records sufficient to record Your Therapy Scource compliance with itsobligations under Paragraph. Idf this Order

IV.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each Respondent shall submit verified written reports ("compliance eports") in accordance with the following:

- A. Each Respondent shallubmit
  - 1. an interim compliance report 60 days for the Order is issued
  - 2. an annualcompliance eport one year after the date this Order is issued and annually for the next 3 years on the anniversary of that date; and
  - 3. additional compliance eports as the Commission its staff may request
