DECISION

The Federal Trade Commission ("Commission") initiated an investigation of certain acts and practices of Your Therapy Source, Neeraj Jindal, and Sheri Yarbray, collectively "Respondents." The Commission's Bureau of Competition prepared and furnished to Respondents the Draft Complaint, which it proposed to present to the Commission for its consideration issued by the Commission, the Draft Complaint would charge Respondents with violations of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 45.

Respondents and the Bureau of Competition executed an agreement ("Agreement Containing Consent Order" or "Consent Agreement") containing (12) dmission by Respondents of all the jurisdictional facted forth in the Draft Complaint, (2) a statement that the signing of said agreement is for settlement purposes only and does nto the that the signing of said agreement that the law has been violated as all the Draft Complaint, or that the facts as alleged in the Draft Oplaint, other than jurisdictional facts, are true(3) waivers and other provisions as required by the Commission's Rules, and (4) a proposed Decision and Order.

The Commission considered the matter and determined that it had reason to believe that Respondents have violated the said Act, and that a complaint should issue stating its charges in that respective Commissionaccepted the Consent Agreement and placed it on the public record for a period of 30 days for the receipt and consideration of

public comments The Commission duly considered any comments received from interested persons pursuant to Commission Rule 2.34, 16 C.F.R. § 2.34. Now, in further conformity with the procedure desibed in Rule 2.34, the Commission issues its Complaint, makes the following jurisdictional findings d issues the following Decision and Order ("Order"):

1. Respondent Your Therapy Source C is a limited liability companyorganized, existing, and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the C Texas and its principal address is 8624 Mid Cities Blvd., Suite 200, North Richard Hills, Texas 76182.)

- F. "Home Health Agency" means any Person that contracts with one or more Therapist Staffing Competitors to provide Therapist services to home health patients.
- G. "Pay Rate" means the payment Respondents or Therapist Staffing Competitos make to Therapist to treat patients
- H. "Person" means any individual, partnership, corporation, business trust, limited liability company, limited liability partnership, joint stock company, trust, unincorporated association, joint venture, or other entity or a government body.
- I. "Therapist" means a physical therapist, physical therapist assistant, occupational therapist, occupational therapist
- J. "Therapist Staffing" means the provision of Therapists to treat patients through contractual arraegnents by and betweetherapist Staffing Competitors and Rerapists
- K. "Therapist Staffing Competitor" means any Person engaged in the business of Therapist Staffing.

II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in connection with establishing the Compensation of any employee or independent contractor, including Therapists, in or edtl.

submit an original and 2 copies of each compliance report as required by Commission Rule 2.41(a), 16 C.F.R. § 2.41(a), including a paper original submitted to the Secretary of the Commission and electronic copies to the Secretary at ElectronicFilings@ftc.gand to the Compliance Division at bccompliance@ftc.gov

D. For purposes of this paragraph, Respondent Your Therapy Source and Respondent Yarbyamay submit a joint compliance report.

V.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent Your Therapy Source shall notify the Commissiontdeast 30 days prior to:

- A. Any proposed dissolution of Your Therapy SoundeC;
- B. Any proposed acquisition merger, or consolidation of Your Therapy Source, LLC; and
- C. Any other change in Respondent Your Therapy Source including, but not limited to, assignment and the creation or dissolution of subsidiaries, if such change might affect compliance obligations immig out of this Order.

VI.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for 3 years from the date this Order becomes final, each Respondent shall notify the Commission program
