Thank you for commenting on the Federal Trade Commission's proposed consent agreement in the above-referenced proceeding. The Commission has considered your comment and placed it on the public record pursuant to Rule 4.9(b)(6)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 4.9(b)(6)(ii).

In your comment, you discuss the legal status of Formosa, and state that, to the extent Williams-Sonoma, Inc. products are produced by "legal or natural person[s] arising from Formosa . . . the products are made 'in America.'" You do not propose any revisions to the draft Complaint or Decision and Order.
