Findings

Delivery must occur within ten (10) days after the Effective date of this Order for current personnel. For all others, delivery must occur before they assume responsibil ities.
- C. From each individual or entity to which Respondent del ivered a copy of this Order, Respondent must obtain, within thirty(30) days, a signed and dated acknowl edgment of receipt of this Order.
