Complaint Counsel and Respondents have now filed a joint motion to dismiss the Complaint on the grounds that Respondents do not intend to seek further judicial review of the Eighth Circuit's decision and "will abandon the proposed transaction."<sup>2</sup>

In light of Respondents' decision to abandon the proposed transaction, the most important elements of the relief set out in the Notice of Contemplated Relief in the Complaint have been accomplished without the need for further administrative litigation.<sup>3</sup> For the foregoing reasons, the Commission has determined that the public interest warrants dismissal of the Complaint in this matter. The Commission has determined to do so without prejudice, however, because it is not reaching a decision on the merits.

Accordingly,

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the Complaint in this matter be, and it hereby is, dismissed without prejudice.
