Complaint Counsel and Respondents filed a joint motion to withdraw this matter from adjudication to enable the Commission to consider a proposed Consent Agreement. Complaint Counsel and Counsel for the Respondents submitted a proposed Consent Agreement containing a proposed Decision and Order. If the proposed Consent Agreement receives final approval by the Commission, it would resolve this matter in its entirety. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 3.25(d) of the Commission Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(d), that this matter in its entirety is withdrawn from adjudication, and that all proceedings before the Commission are stayed while the Commission evaluates the proposed Consent Agreement, pursuant to Rules 3.25(e) and (f), 16 C.F.R. § 3.25 (e) and (f).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 3.25(b) of the Commission Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(b), that the Consent Agreement shall not be placed on the public record unless and until it is accepted by the Commission.
