ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On February 22, 2018, the Commission issued an Administrative Complaint alleging that Respondents Wilhelm Wilhelmsen and Wilhelmsen Maritime Services AS (collectively “Respondents”) violated Section 7 of the Clayton Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. § 18, and Section 5 of the FTC Act.

On May 4, 2018, pursuant to Section 13(b) of the FTC Act and Section 16 of the Clayton Act, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia seeking a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction to prevent Respondents from consummating the proposed acquisition until final resolution of this

administrative proceeding.¹ On July 21, 2018, the District Court issued an Order granting the Commission's request for a preliminary injunction.²

Complaint Counsel and Respondents have now filed a Joint Motion to dismiss the Administrative
