A. The United States retains and reserves a right to enforce the provisions of this Final Judgment, including the right to seek an order of contempt from the Court. Defendant agrees that in a civil contempt action, a motion to show cause, or a similar action brought by the United States regarding an alleged violation of this Final Judgment, the United States may establish a violation of this Final Judgment and the appropriateness of a remedy therefor by a preponderance of the evidence, and Defendant waives any argument that a different standard of proof should apply.

B. This Final Judgment should be interpreted to give full effect to the cooperative purposes of the anti-rust laws, including Section 7A of the Clayton Act and Regulations promulgated hereunder. Defendant agrees that he may be held in contempt of, and that he
