invoked the aid of this Court, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 81(a)(5), for an order requiring Respondent Humana, Inc. to comply in full with the April 10, 2017 subpoena *duces tecum* issued to it in a merger investigation being conducted by the FTC (FTC File No. 161-0026). The Court has considered the Emergency Petition of the FTC for an Order Enforcing Subpoena *Duces Tecum* Issued in a Merger Investigation and the papers filed in support thereof; and it appears to the Court that Petitioner has shown good cause for the entry of this Order. Accordingly, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that Respondent appear at 2:00 PM on June 22, 2017, in Courtroom No. 6 of the United States Courthouse in Washington, D.C., and show cause, if any there be, why this Court should not grant said Petition and enter an Order enforcing the subpoena issued to Respondent and directing it to produce, no later than June 26 2017, all responsive materials. Unless the Court determines otherwise, notwithstanding the filing or pendency of any procedural or other motions, all issues raised by the Petition and supporting papers, and any opposition to the Petition, will be
