The Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Competition has been conducting a nonpublic investigation to determine hether the Texts Medical Board or anyother unnamed persons, partnerships, or corporations have engaged or are engaging in conduct that violate Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, as amended, 15 U.S.C. \$45, through the adoption and enforcement of rules related to the provision of telemedicine services by phylicians.

Upon further reviews this matter, it now appears that no further action is warranted by the Commission at this time. Accordingly the investigation has been closed. This action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation maynot have occurred, just as the pendency of an investigation should not be construed as a determination that a violation that a violation has occurred.
