Dear Mr. Kick:

This is in response to your request dated January 10, 2018, under the Freedom of Information Act seeking access to the most recent Independent Assessor's Report on Google's Privacy Program and updates on Google's initial compliance report regarding the program. In accordance with the FOIA and agency policy, we are providing you with the information requested as of the date we received your request in our FOIA request log.

We have located 58 pages of records. I am granting partial access to the records, portions of which are exempt from disclosure under FOIA Exemption 5, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5), because they are withheld from public release pursuant to the provisions of 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5), A.R.C. 975 F.2d 871, 879 (D.C. Cir. 1992). Moreover, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C), which exempts from disclosure information that is exempt from disclosure under another Federal statute.

If you are not satisfied with this response, you may file a request for review with the Office of Information Policy, Federal Trade Commission, 1400 Constitution Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20580, or via email at FOIAAppeal@ftc.gov, within 90 days of the date of this letter. Please enclose a copy of your original request and a copy of this response.
