Google complaints (anti-competitive practices)

Dear Mr. Sankin:

This is in response to your request dated April 18, 2017, under the Freedom of Information Act regarding Google complaints (anti-competitive practices). In accordance with the FOIA and agency policy, we have searched our records, as of April 19, 2017, the date we received your request.

Enclosed are 16 responsive complaints from the American Bar Association and the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC"). Many of the complaints have not necessarily been verified by the FTC. I am denying access to the identifying information for FOIA Exemption 1, 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(1) because the general public's interest in seeing personal identifying information is outweighed by the FTC, 352 F.3d 1122 (7th Cir. 2005).
