

**Opening Remarks

AT&T Mobility Complaint Press Call  
October 28, 2014**

Good afternoon and thank you for joining on this call. Today, we are announcing the latest in a series of law enforcement actions the Federal Trade Commission has taken to protect American consumers in the expanding mobile marketplace.

The FTC has filed a complaint in federal court against AT&T Mobility, Inc., charging that the company has misled millions of its mobile customers by charging them for so-called “unlimited”

mobile commerce continues to grow at a rapid pace, the Commission's action today should leave no doubt that our commitment to protecting consumers fully extends to the mobile world.
