II. Making a FOIA Request

All FOIA requests must be in the form an interest prizely describing the records sought. Any request for nonpublicards will be handled as a FOIA request regardless of how it is identified, but requests should be identified as a "FOIA request" in order to avoid delay in processing.

FOIA requests should contain a precise **dption** of the record sought, including the subject matter, relevant time period, **thre**dname and address of any company to which the request pertains. Requests shadd include an agreement to pay any FOIA processing fees and the requests address and telephone number.

2. Brief description of why some requests are not granted and an overview of certain general categories of records which the FOIA exemptions apply.

The FTC primarily receives requests tonsumer complaints regarding a company's business practices drequests for records relating to the FTC's law enforcement investigations. The majority requests that a reitially denied, or partially denied, are based on personal acy concerns reflected in FOIA Exemption 6. Many denials are also duestatutory constraints on disclosure or because disclosure would terfere with ongoing law enforcement activities.

- 2. Basic terms, expressed in common terminology:
  - a. Administrative Appeal a request to a federal agencesking that it eview at a higher administrative level a FOIA denteination made by the agency at the initial request level.
  - b. Average Number—the number obtained by diving the sum of a group of numbers by the quantity of numbers group. For example, of 3, 7, and 14, the average number is 8.
  - c. Backlog— the number of requests or adminitistrea appeals that re pending at an agency at the end of the fiscal yeardare beyond the statutory time period for a response.
  - d. Component– for agencies that process rests on a decentralized basis, a "component" is an entity, also sometimes rest to as an Office, Division, Bureau, Center, or Directorate, within the agentbat processes FOIAequests. The FOIA now requires that agenciesclude in their Annual FOIA Report data for both the agency overall and for each principal component of the agency.
  - e. Consultation— the procedure whereby the agenesyponding to a FOIA request first forwards a record to another agenoryits review because that other agency has an interest in the document. Once agency in receipt the consultation finishes its review of the cord, it responds back to tagency that forwarded it. That agency, in turn, will the respond to the FOIA requester.
  - f. Exemption 3 Statute— a federal statute that exemptiformation from disclosure and which the agency relies on to withholftormation under subsection (b)(3) of the FOIA.

g. FOIA Request— a FOIA request is generally request to a federal agency for access to records concerning another person (i.e., a planity) request), or concerning an organization, or a particular of interest. FOIA requests also include requests made by the seeking records not cerning themselves (i.e., "first pearty" requests) when the sequesters are not subject to the Privacy Act, such as noted. S. citizens. Moreover, because all fipeatry requesters should be afforded the benefit of both the access vipsions of the FOIA as well as those of the Privacy Act, FOIA requests also include any first array requests where an agency determines that it must seately ond its Privacy Act "systems of records" or where a Privacy Act exemption applies the agency looks to FOIA to afford the greatest possible access. All requests he require the agency to utilize the FOIA in responding to the requestare included in this Report.

Additionally, a FOIA requestrictudes records referred to the agency for processing and direct response torthoguester. It does not, however, include records for which the agency has receive consultation from another agency. (Consultations are reported separatelly Section XII of this Report.)

- h. Full Grant an agency decision to disclosderecords in full in response to a FOIA request.
- i. Full Denial an agency decision not to release any records in response to a FOIA request because the records are extennitheir entirties under one or more of the FOIA exemptions, or beseuof a procedural reason, such as when no records could be located.
- j. Median Number the middle, not average, nuerb For example, of 3, 7, and 14, the median number is 7.
- k. Multi Terack Processing— a system in which simple requests requiring relatively minimal review are place one processing track and more voluminous and complex requests are place in one or more other tracks. Requests granted expedite ob coessing are place in yeartother track. Requests in each track are processed of irrest in/first out basis.
  - i. Expedited Processing an agency will process a FOIA request on an expedited basis when a requester **sets** the requirements for expedited processing as set forth in the taste and in agency regulations.
  - ii. Simple Request— a FOIA request that agency using multipack processing places in its fastest (next processing places in its fastest (next process) track based on the low volume and/or simplicity of the records requested.

- iii. Complex Request– a FOIA request that an agency using mattick processing places in a slower transsed on the the volume and/or complexity of the records requested.
- I. Partial Grant/Partial Denial in response to a FOIA request, an agency decision to disclose portions of the redspand to withhold other portions that are exempt under the FOIA, or to otherwood a portion of the request for a procedural reason.
- m. Pending Request or Peding Administrative Appeal a request or administrative appeal for which an agency has not taken final action in all respects.
- n. Perfected Request a request for records white asonably describes such records and is made in accordance with blished rules stating the time, place, fees (if any) and proceedes to be followed.
- o. Processed Request or Processed Administrative Appeala request or administrative appeal for which an ageillass taken final action in all respects.
