DECISION Respondents). The Commission's Bureau of Competition prepared and furnished to Respondent the Draft Complaint, which it proposed to Commission for its consideration. Issued by the Commission the Draft Complaint charges Respondents with violations of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 5.

Respondents and the Bureau of Competition executed an Agreement Consent Order (Consent Agreement) containing (1) an admission by Respondents of all jurisdictional facts in the Draft Complaint, (2) a stipulation that the facts in the Draft Complaint, other than jurisdictional facts, are true, (3) a consent to the remedies and other procedures required by the Commission's Rules, and (4) a proposed Decision and Order.

The Commission considered the matter and determined that it had jurisdiction over Respondents. The Commission accepted the Consent Agreement and proposed Decision and Order.
