I hope that you are well, today. I've got a question about how to complete Item 7(c)(iv)(a). I believe that the form auto-populates the information in Item 7(c)(iv)(a), it only adds one row for each code, and there seems to be a character limit in each row. However, I have over 200 locations to list by state, county, city, street address, and these will not fit into one row.
How do I submit these? Should I create a new row for each location that doesn't fit into a single row, or may I create an attachment and state "7(c)(iv)(a) - See Attachment 7(c)(iv)(a) 2-1-22" for example?
Also, I had one [REDACTED] that populates "FL". Do you know what I may be doing wrong?
