You are correct that your Item 5(a) response needs to report in 2017 10-digit NAPCS codes. You can look up an appropriate 2017 NAPCS code in the "Manufacturing and Mining" tab of <https://www2.census.gov/programs-surveys/economic-census/technical-documentation/napcs/>. You should select your 2017 NAPCS codes from Column D code (2012 Published) and the 10-digit code you select from Column G should map to a Column D code (2012 Published) 10-digit code as the 2017 NAICS code that you are reporting.
