AGREEMENT CONTAINING CONSENT ORDER

The Federal Trade Commission initiated an investigation of certain acts and practices of Planned Building Services, Inc., Planned Lifestyle Services Inc., Planned Security Services, Inc., and Planned Technologies Services, Inc. (individually or collectively, “Planned” or “Proposed Respondents”). The Commission’s Bureau of Competition has prepared a draft administrative complaint (“Draft Complaint”). The Bureau of Competition and Proposed Respondents enter into this Agreement Containing Consent Order (“Consent Agreement”) to cease and desist from engaging in certain acts and practices and to provide for other relief to resolve the allegations in the Draft Complaint through a proposed Decision and Order, which is attached, to present to the Commission.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between Proposed Respondents, by their duly authorized officers and attorneys, and counsel for the Commission that:

1. Proposed Respondent Planned Building Services, Inc. is a corporation organized, existing, and doing business under, and by virtue of, the laws of New Jersey, with its executive offices and principal place of business at 150 Smith Road, Parsippany, New Jersey 07054.

- 4. Proposed Respondent Planned Technologies Services, Inc. is a corporation organized, existing, and doing business under and by virtue of, the laws of New Jersey, with its executive offices and principal place of business at 150 Smith Road, Parsippany, New Jersey 07054.

- 5. Proposed Respondent admit all the jurisdictional facts stated in [R]2 ((he)]TJ 1tf)-2T* [((r)-2 (opos)-r)-

Proposed Respondent shall receive an original and one copy of each compliance report. Proposed Respondent shall electronically file an original of each compliance report with the Secretary of the Commission at ElectronicFilings@ftc.gov, and with the Compliance Division at bccompliance@ftc.gov.

10. This Consent Agreement and any compliance report filed pursuant to this Consent Agreement shall not become part of the public record of the proceeding unless and until the Commission accepts the Consent Agreement. If the Commission accepts this Consent Agreement, the Commission will place together with the Complaint, the proposed Decision and Order, an explanation of the provisions of the proposed Decision and Order, and other information that may help interested persons understand the Decision and Order on the public record for the receipt of comments for 30 days.
11. This Consent Agreement contemplates that the Commission accepts the Consent Agreement. The Commission thereafter may withdraw its acceptance of this Consent Agreement and notify Proposed Respondent. In which event the Commission will take such action as it may consider appropriate. If the Commission does not subsequently withdraw such acceptance pursuant to the provisions of Commission Rule 2.34, 16 C.F.R. § 2.34, the Commission may, without further notice to Proposed Respondent, issue its Complaint and the attached Decision and Order containing an order to cease and desist and to provide for other relief in disposition of the proceeding.

- b. all subsidiaries, affiliates, and successors necessary to effectuate the full relief contemplated by this Consent Agreement and the Decision and Order are parties to this Consent Agreement and are bound as if they had signed this Consent Agreement and were made parties to this proceeding within the control of parties to this Consent Agreement and the Decision and Order
15. Proposed Respondents have read the Draft Complaint and the proposed Decision and Order. Proposed Respondents agree to comply with the terms of the proposed Decision and Order from the date they sign this Consent Agreement. Proposed Respondents understand that once the Commission has issued the Decision and Order, they will be required to file one or more compliance reports setting forth in detail the manner in which they have complied, have prepared to comply, are complying, and will comply with the Decision and Order. When final the Decision and Order shall have the same force and effect and may be altered, modified, or set aside in the same manner and within the same time as provided by statute for other orders. Proposed Respondents further understand that they may be liable for civil penalties in the amount provided by law for each violation of the Decision and Order
