Meta's response raised a number of threshold legal issues in this
proceeding, among other arguments and factual assertions. To resolve
these threshold issues, on May 30, 2018, the Commission directed Complaint
within thirty days, a reply to the legal questions raised in Meta's
concerning the Order to Show Cause. Complaint Counsel submitted their reply

The Commission now directs that Meta submit a further reply within thirty days of this
order. The Commission expects to hold oral argument on the threshold legal issues and will set
a date for the argument at a later time. Accordingly,
