

On August 26, 2022, Respondent Meta Platforms, Inc. (“Meta”) filed a motion to stay this administrative proceeding until after a ruling in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California in *FTC v. Meta Platforms, Inc.*, No. 5:22-cv-04325-EJD on the Commission’s complaint

§ 4.3(b). As the Commission has previously determined, the Petition for Recusal should be decided before the Motion to Stay. Order Extending Deadline to Rule on Respondent's Motion to Stay at 2 (Oct. 21, 2022). The Petition for Recusal is still pending. To give the Commission time to complete its consideration of the Petition for Recusal and then to fully consider the Motion to Stay, we find good cause to extend the deadline for a decision on the Motion to Stay until December 21, 2022.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Commission's deadline to rule on Respondent's Motion to Stay This Administrative Proceeding is extended until December 21, 2022.
