**ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On February 17, 2023, non-party Valve Corporation (“Valve”) filed a motion to extend the time for it to file a motion to quash or to limit a subpoena served on Valve by Federal Trade Commission Complaint Counsel (“Motion”). Valve states that Complaint Counsel and Valve are engaged in ongoing negotiations as to the scope of document production and that further negotiations may narrow or eliminate areas of dispute. Valve further states that Complaint Counsel agrees to the extension requested in the Motion.

Upon review and consideration of the Motion, the Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that Valve’s deadline to file a motion to quash or to limit Complaint Counsel’s subpoena is extended to February 27, 2023.
