Under FTC Rule of Practice 3.34(c), any motion to limit or quash ~~posua~~ must be filed within the earlier of ten days of service of the subpoena or the time for compliance therewith. Google seeks an extension of time in order to continue its negotiations with Microsoft regarding the subpoena, thereby narrowing potential discovery disputes.

FTC Rule 4.3(b) authorizes the Administrative Law Judge, except in circumstances not KHUH SUHVHQWHG WR H[WHQG DQ\ WLPH OLPLW SUHVFULF C.F.R. § 4.3(b). Based on the representations in the Motion, Google has demonstrated good cause for the requested extension. Accordingly, the Motion is GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED WKDW \*RRJOH ¶ V GH DGOLQH IRU ILOLQJ DQ\ PRWLRQ WR OLPLW is extended to March 3, 2023.
