> Concurring and Dissenting Statement of Commissioner Andrew N. Ferguson Joined by Commissioner Melissa Holyoak Regarding the FTC Staff Report on AI Partnerships & Investments 6(b) Study Matter Number P246201

Today, the Commission votes to release a **septo**rt about the partnerships between three Big Tech giants (Amazon, Google, and Microsoft) and t**wicica** intelligence ("AI") developers (Anthropic and OpenAI). AI technology

Section 6(b) study was quick—concludiwighin ayear⁵—andnotablynarrow in scope, covering only three partnershipsetweenfive companies. Such an approach may have been appropriate rapid developments within the AI industry required speed to ensuse at the export's relevance. But the limited, brief nature of the study should foreclose the drawing of broad conclusions about the AI industry and its future, or even about the artnerships themselves. The staff report acknowledges as much, deploying hedging language throughout the 5 and that "an analysis of the impact that these partnerships might have on competition is beyond the scope of this report".⁶ The Commission therefore should not have published speculation the the future may hold.Readersshould skip Section for the Report or read it with tremendous skepticism.
